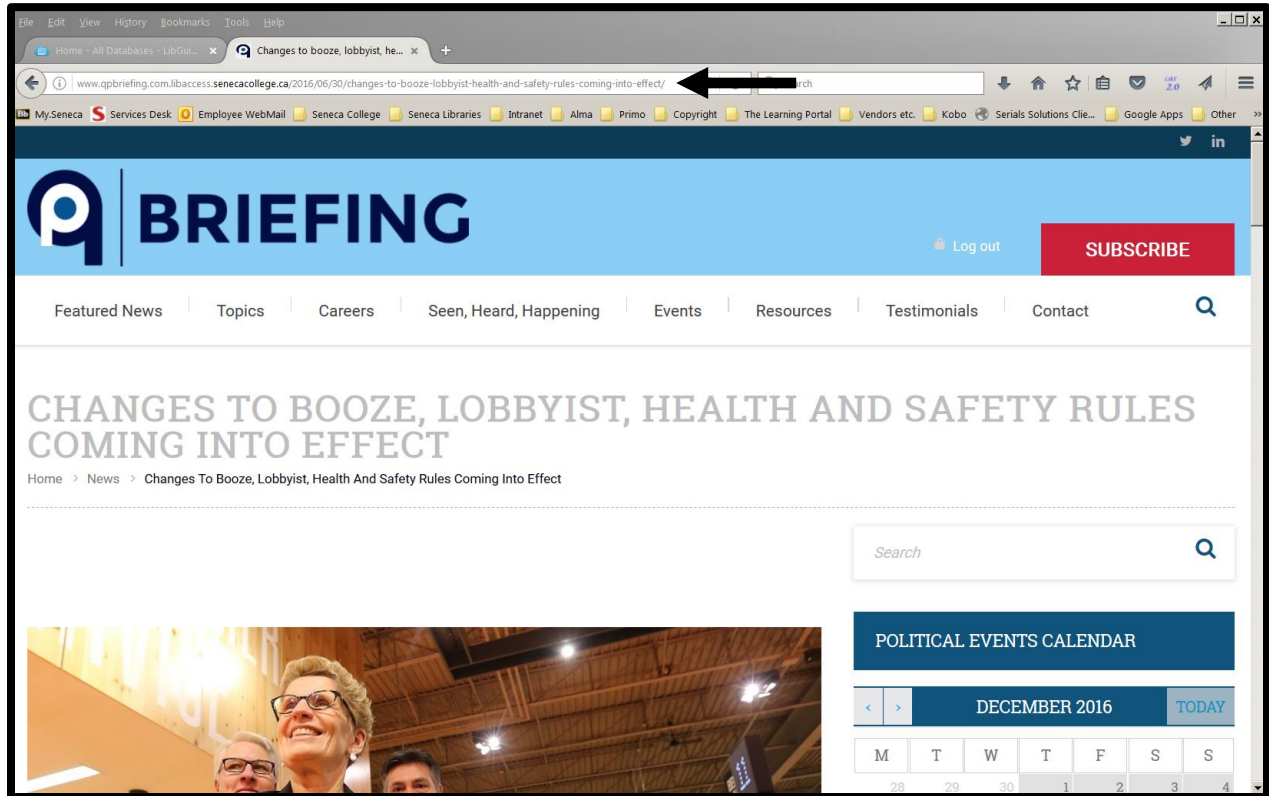


## OBTAINING PERSISTENT LINKS TO CONTENT IN QP BRIEFING

2. URLs for content in QP Briefing contain a date, starting with the year of the post. Replace everything before the year (in the case above, 2016) with ...
