WHAT'S LIBRARY SEARCH?

Library Search is a search engine for **most** of the libraries' content, both physical and digital.

Library Search is the search box on the libraries' home page.

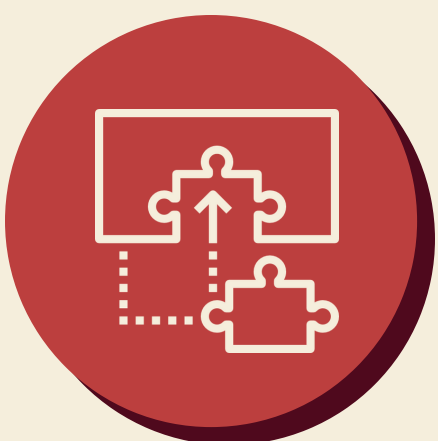


* IMPORTANT TO KNOW *

Library Search finds content from most of our databases, but **not all of our databases**.

WHY CAN'T I SEARCH ALL OF THE DATABASES AT ONCE?

Some database providers don't work with Library Search because their platforms can't be connected to it.

Specialized business, legal, and encyclopedic materials are typically not covered by Library Search.

TIP: SEARCH INDIVIDUAL DATABASES

Search a specific database directly on its own platform to take advantage of its full content and functionality.
